


What Is Greywater?

Greywater is a lightly-polluted wastewater generated from activities such as taking shower, washing clothes, washing hands, washing kitchen utensils, etc. This wastewater largely contains suspended solids, dissolved soap and negligible percentage of bacteria.

Breakup of Daily Water Use



• On-site recycling of greywater and reuse of treated water is Economical and sustainable.



- Conservation of 30–35% freshwater by using treated water for toilet flushing, gardening, floor cleaning.
- Improvement of Hygiene and Sanitation in common facilities such as public toilets and urinals.
- Reduced impact on environment and water bodies because of reduction in sewage generation.
